- Facilitate and administer the organization's consolidated monthly performance management process (policy deployment)
- Working closely with the Process Equipment Group President and his staff to drive agendas, meeting minutes, action items and any key follow ups to drive the business
- Work with the operating companies to prepare monthly consolidated performance reporting packages and required corporate/board presentations
- Own and manage projects or key assignments as they relate to larger initiatives, including identification of key issues, analysis, development of hypotheses and conclusions, and presentation of findings
